We have registered an interest with Long Eaton's action group and have attended a meeting.

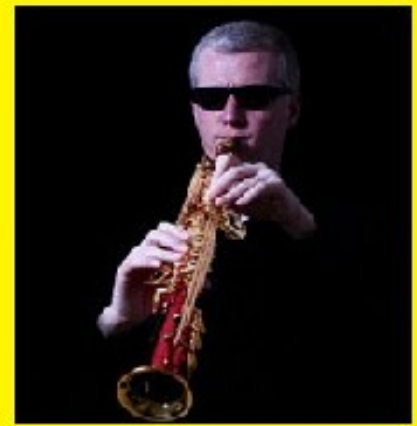
