HS2 - Update

HS2 Ltd came to the village on 18th September 2017. The event was well attended by local residents, 499 in total. Many were able to ask questions and discuss how HS2 will have an effect on this village and on compensation issues. The Parish Council determined at the September full council meeting to oppose the construction of HS2. The Council is aware that the local Stop HS2 action group has gathered 1294 signatures for a petition against HS2. This represents 66 % of the voting electorate of Trowell. Other HS2 Ltd events are planned.

The Pong - Update

A statement from the Environment Agency on Stanton Recycling.

"We are aware of continuing reports of odour issues near Stanton Recycling and the local area around Trowell and Hallam Fields. As part of our work to deal with these issues, we have audited the composting operations of Stanton Recycling on several occasions. In summer 2016, we found that the company was carrying out their initial composting in a large pile (known as a 'block') which restricted air flow. This resulted in the subsequent compost being very hot and therefore likely to give off an odour.

"During an audit we conducted this summer, we observed that the company has now stopped this form of composting. Composting is currently carried out in long piles (known as 'windrows'). Temperatures within the compost are significantly lower than last year.

"In addition to the audits we carried out on site at Stanton Recycling, we have also conducted odour tests in the area around Trowell and Hallam Fields. Results of these tests have been varied. Whilst we are unable to eliminate the risk of strong odour completely, we are in the process of reviewing Stanton Recycling's odour management plan. This will help us make sure the company is taking all reasonable measures to reduce and control odours."
